BACKGROUND CHECK REQUIREMENTS Section 210.254 RSMo requires notification that background checks have been conducted under the provisions of section 210.1080 RSMo.										
Facilities operated by a religious organization that receive federal funds for providing care for children must have qualifying background screening results for child care staff members as defined in 210.1080.1(1) RSMo. Facilities operated by a religious organization and that do_not receive federal funds for providing care for children are not required to have qualifying background screening results for all child care staff members pursuant to 210.1080.9 RSMo. Child care staff members of facilities operated by a religious organization that receive federal funds for providing care for children, with disqualifying background screening results are prohibited from being on the premises during child care hours. Facilities operated by a religious organization that receive federal funds for providing care for children, must request criminal background checks for child care staff members every 5 years, as defined in 210.1080.1(1) RSMo. Service Use one's gifts and talents to put others first, Perseverance: Give continued effort despite challenges. There may be times when harm to students, staff, and the community is significant, and restoration is not possible. Such cases require special attention, and solutions may require time away from the school community. Examples of unacceptable behaviors warranting interventions include but are not limited to: • Bullying • Dishonesty • Disrespect to Staff • Disruptive Conduct or Speech • Physic al Violence • Such actions depending on a case to case basis may result in suspension temporary or permanent. Any other behavior or mischief that doesn't affect the integrity of others, will be redirected using positive methods of support and redirect the child's behavior by providing alternative actions and behaviors that are acceptable.
